The Outreach Coordinator is responsible for the execution and coordination of all outreach activities of the project No Limits. She/he will assist in the delivery and promotion of the programmes and educational outreach activities through processing the design, planning, sourcing, managing resources and budgets, scheduling, coordinating with different external parties and adhering to existing guidelines throughout the full outreach activities development and execution cycle. The Outreach Coordinator will assist in the liaison with schools, NGOs, and differently abled communities, and the operation for students and NGO beneficiaries to attend the No Limits performances.
